1 Introduction

This atlas is intended at providing a useful tool for the wavelength calibration of the VLT/ISAAC and NTT/SOFI spectra. Since OH lines are imprinted on all sky spectra (provided they are deep enough, which might not always be the case for standard stars), they provide an in-situ reference for wavelength calibrating the spectra.

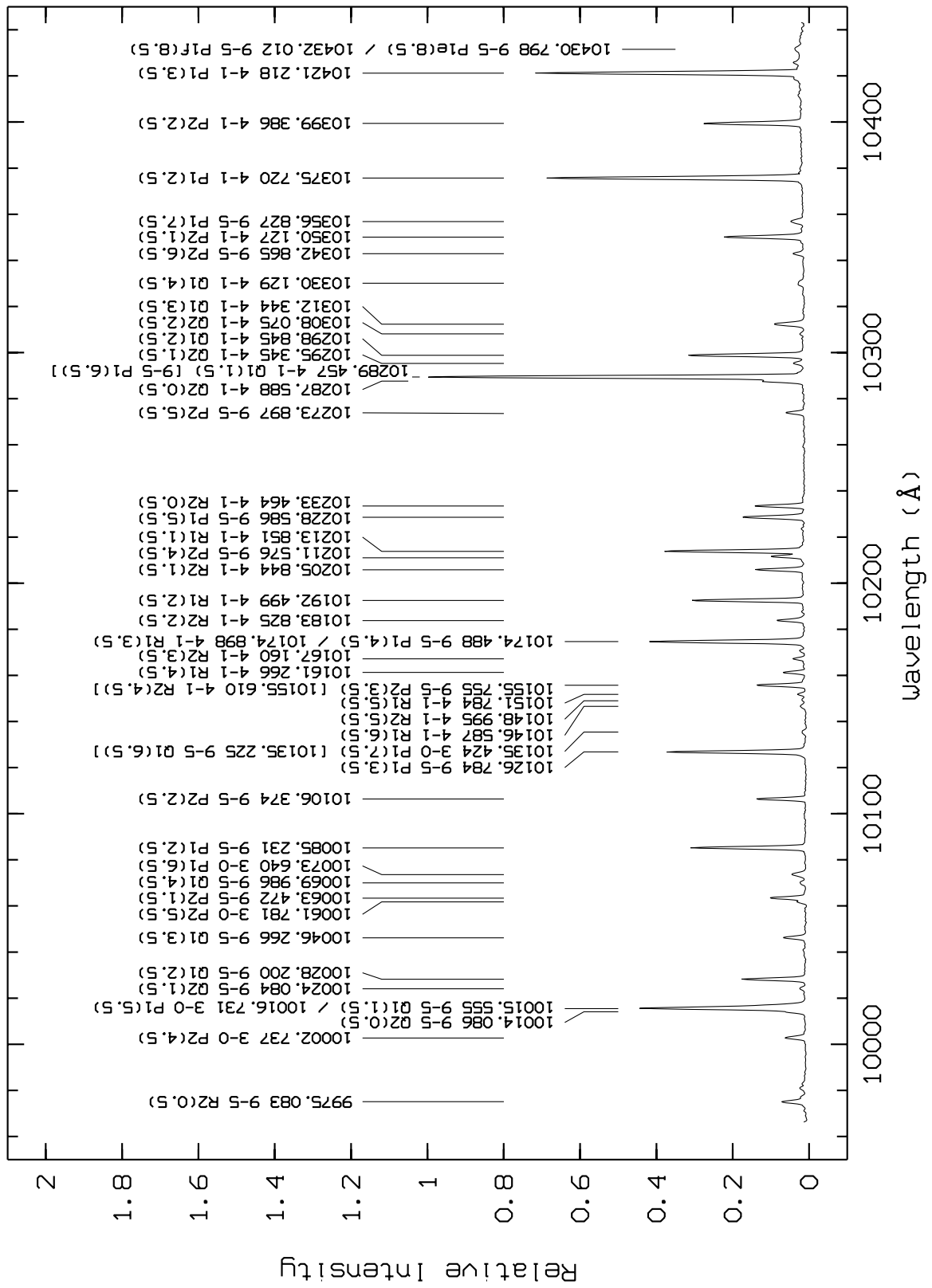


Figure 1: MR spectrum, [0.997–1.044] μm

Figures 1 to 20 display observed spectra with lines identified from the list of OH lines. The O2 lines are also identified.

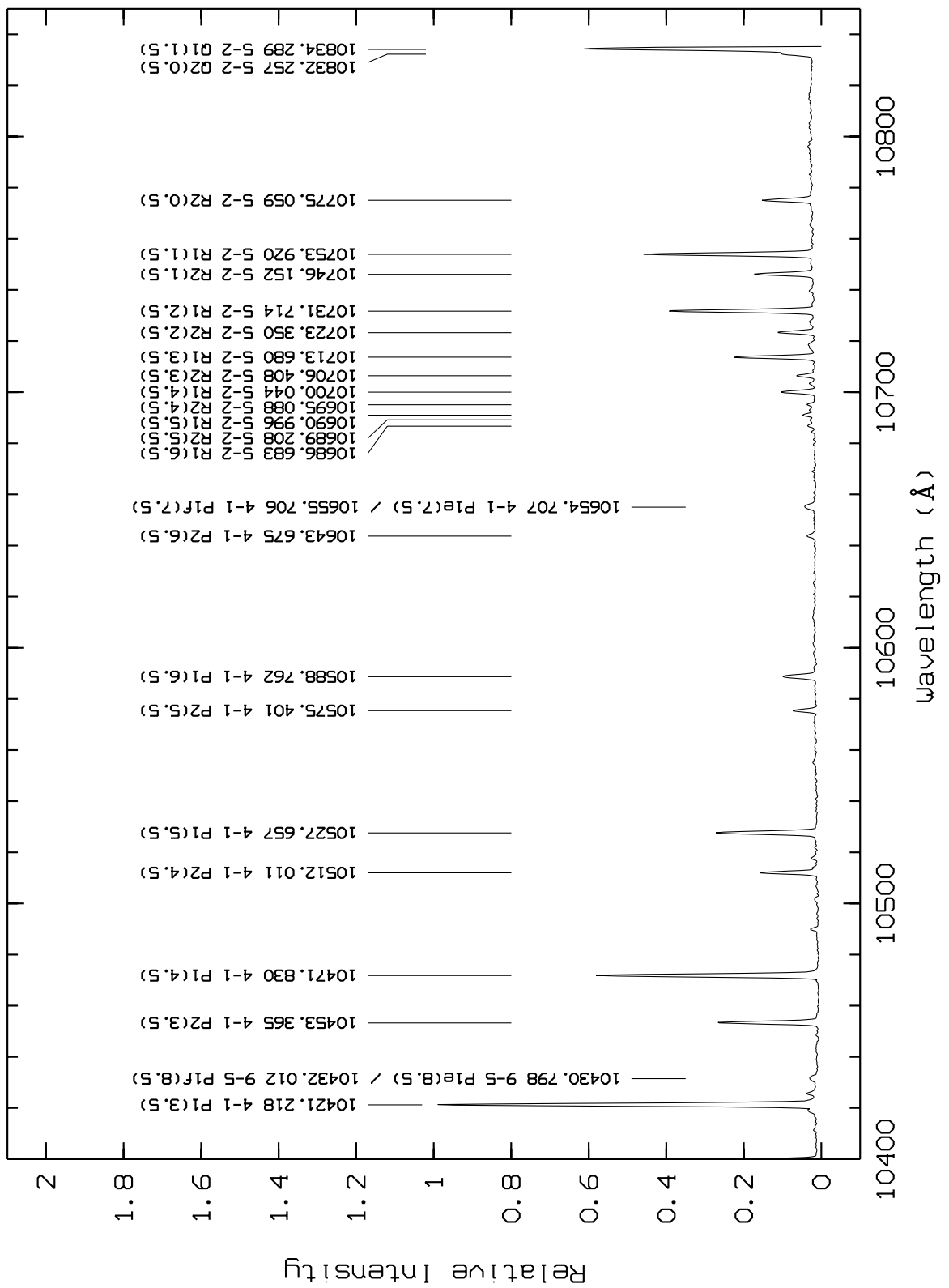


Figure 2: MR spectrum, [1.04–1.084] μm

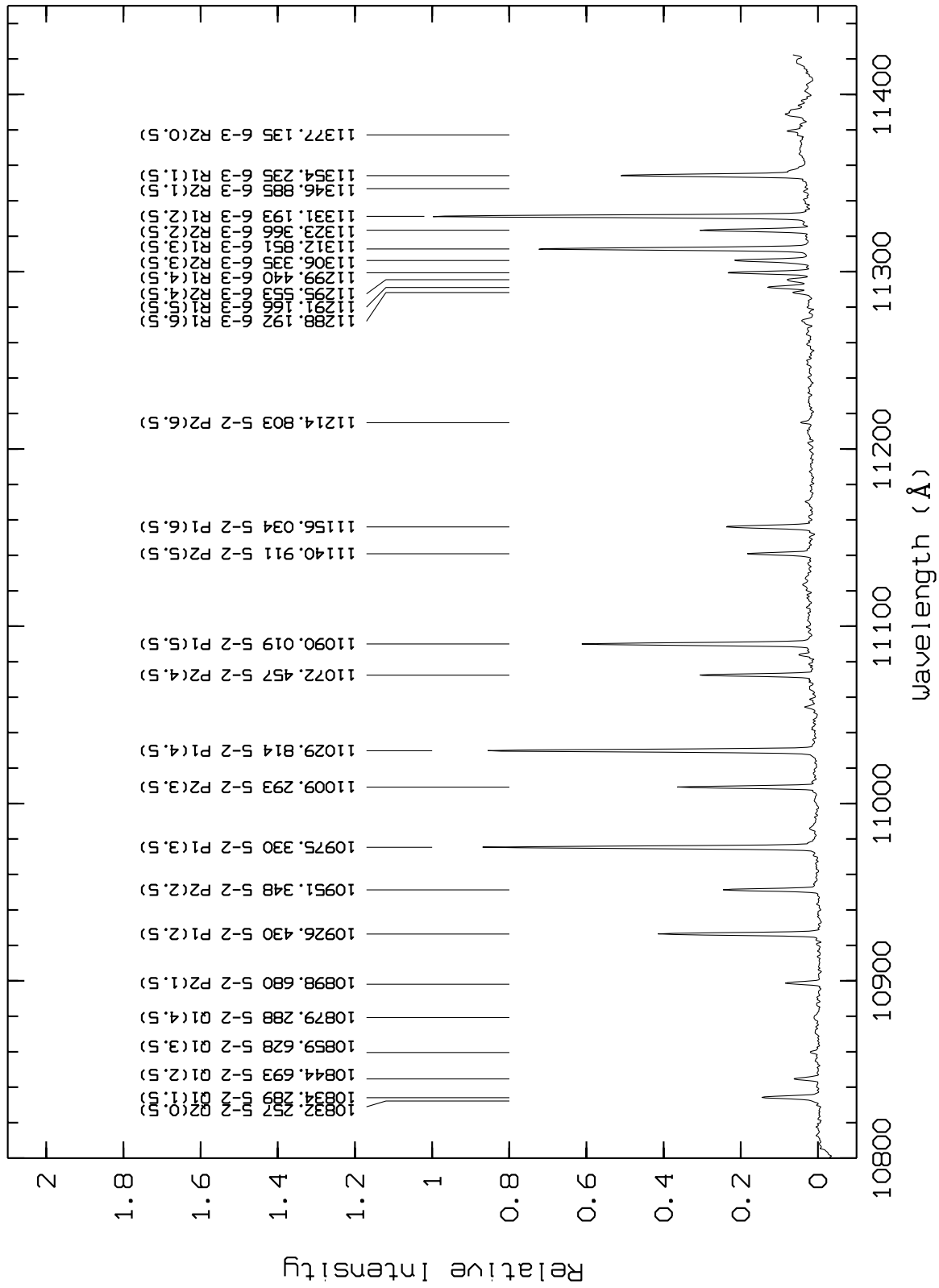


Figure 3: MR spectrum, [1.08–1.142] μm

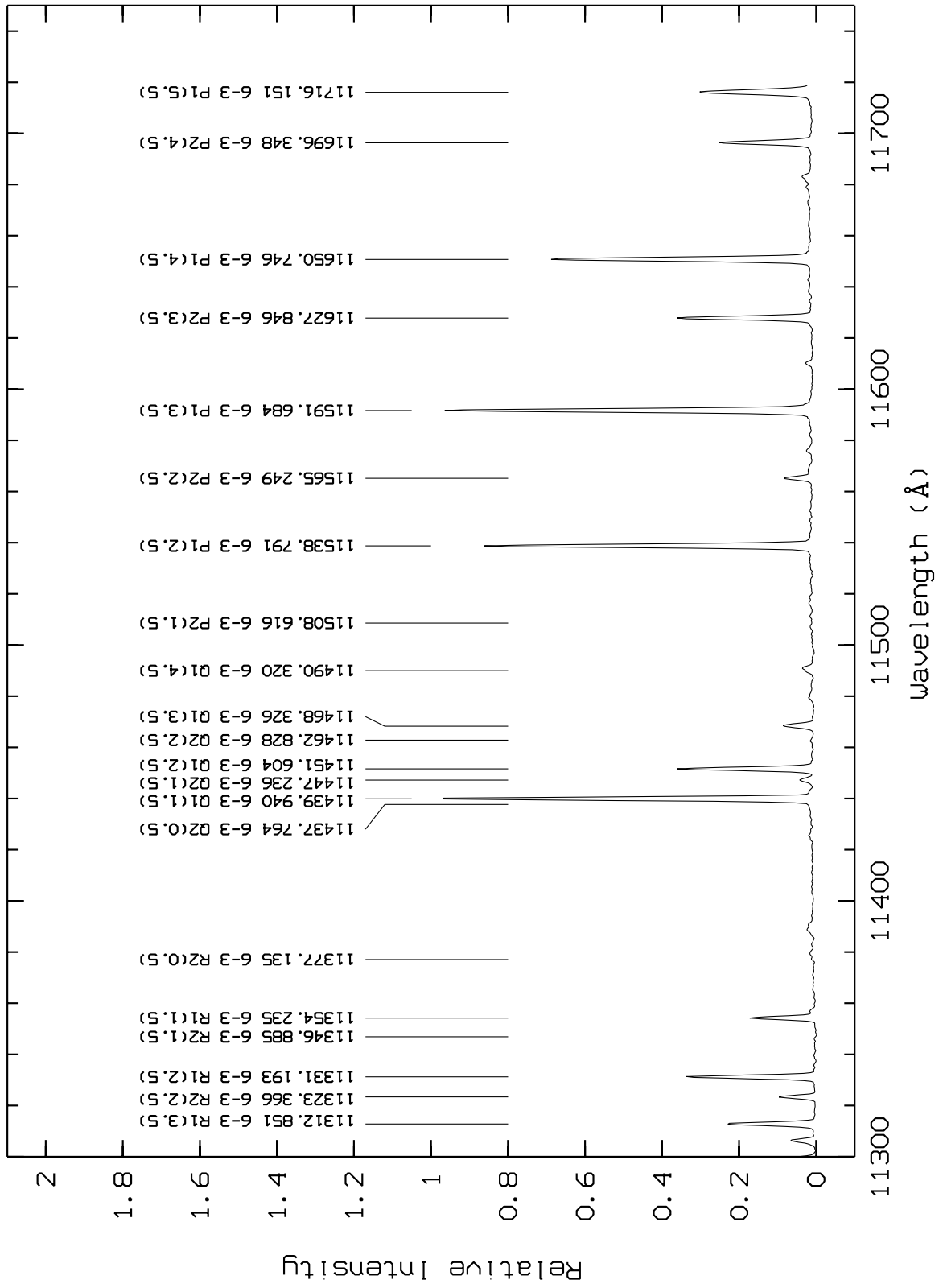


Figure 4: MR spectrum, [1.13–1.172] μm

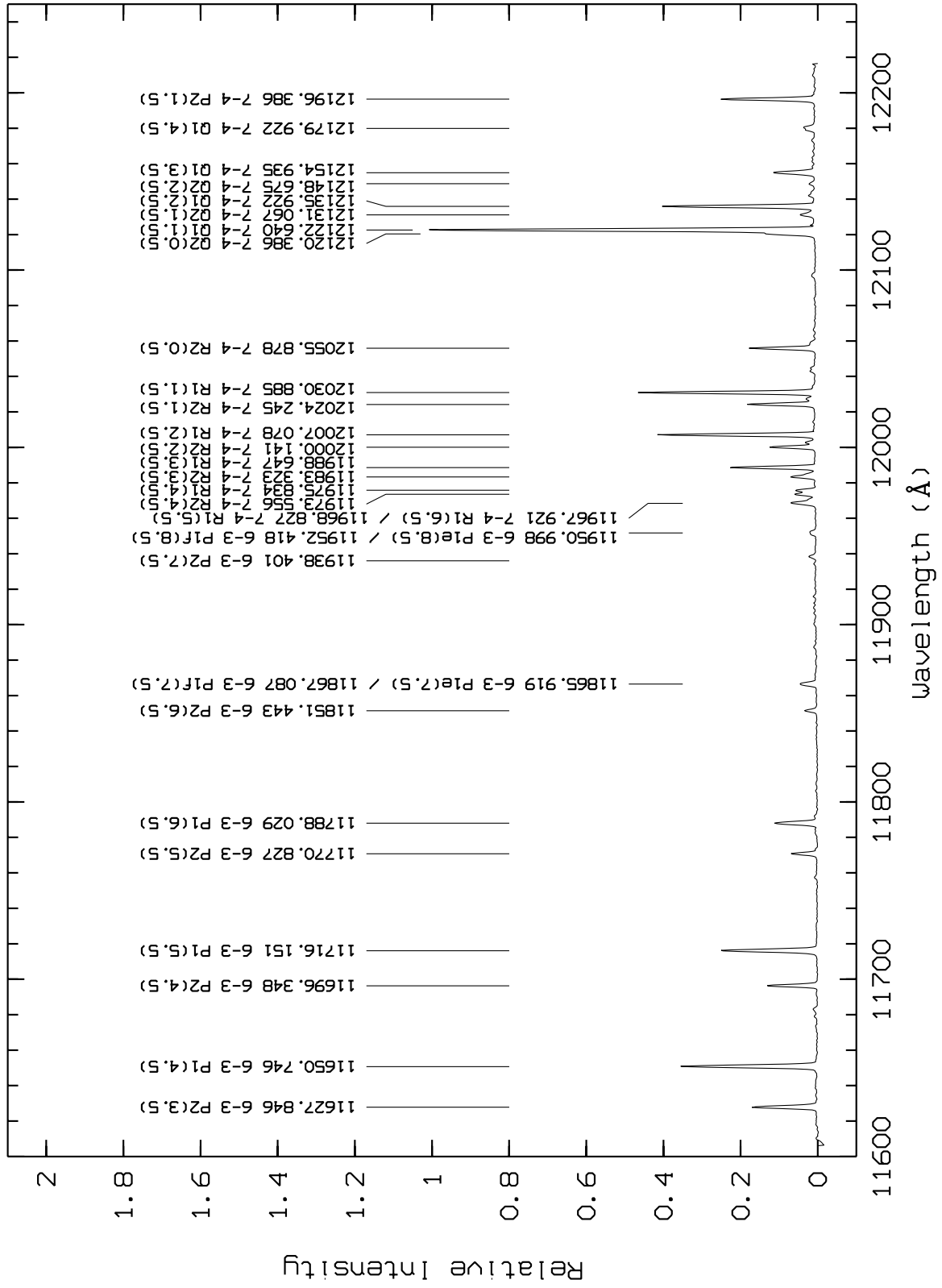


Figure 5: MR spectrum, [1.16–1.222] μm

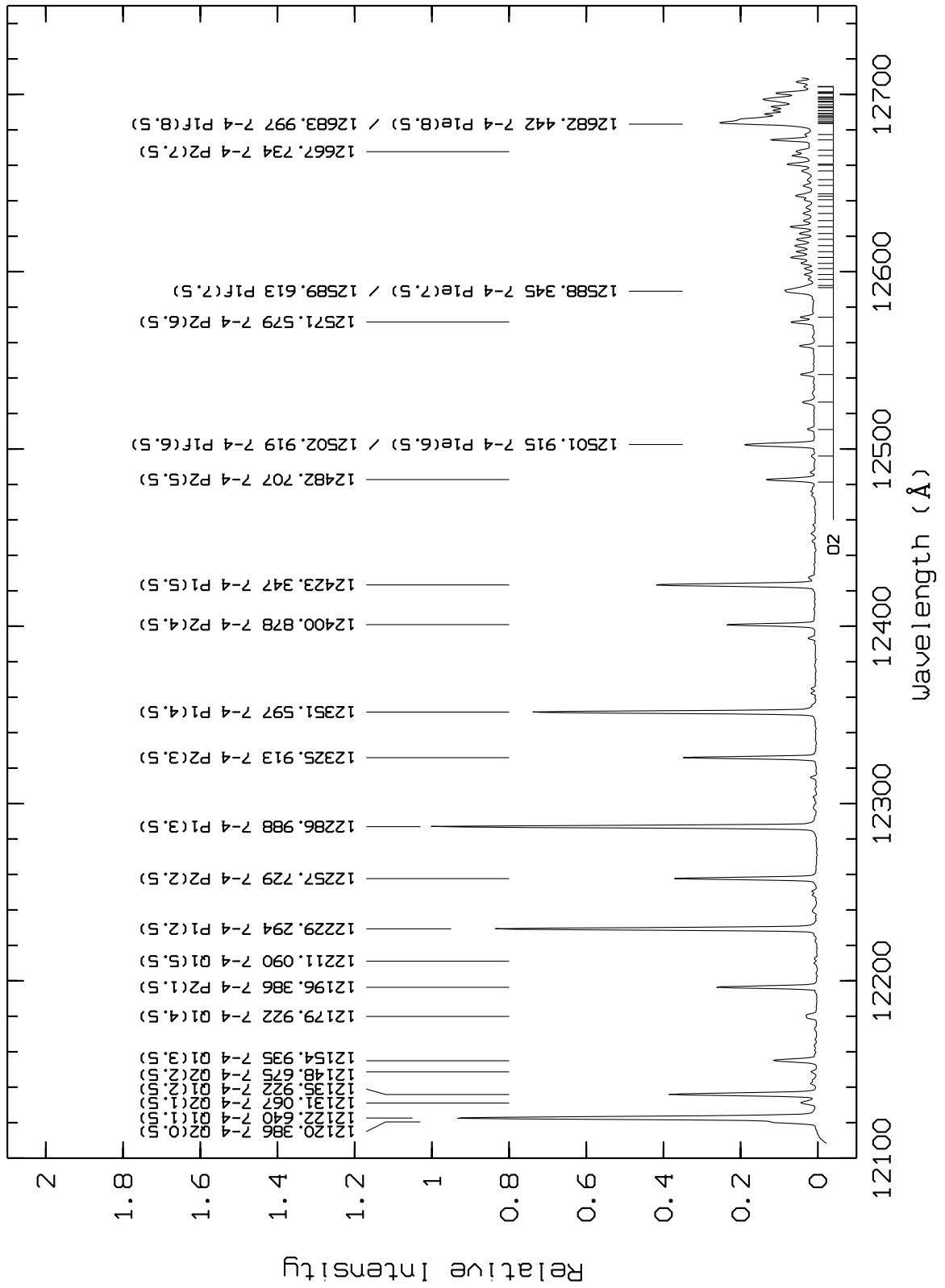


Figure 6: MR spectrum, [1.21–1.271] μm

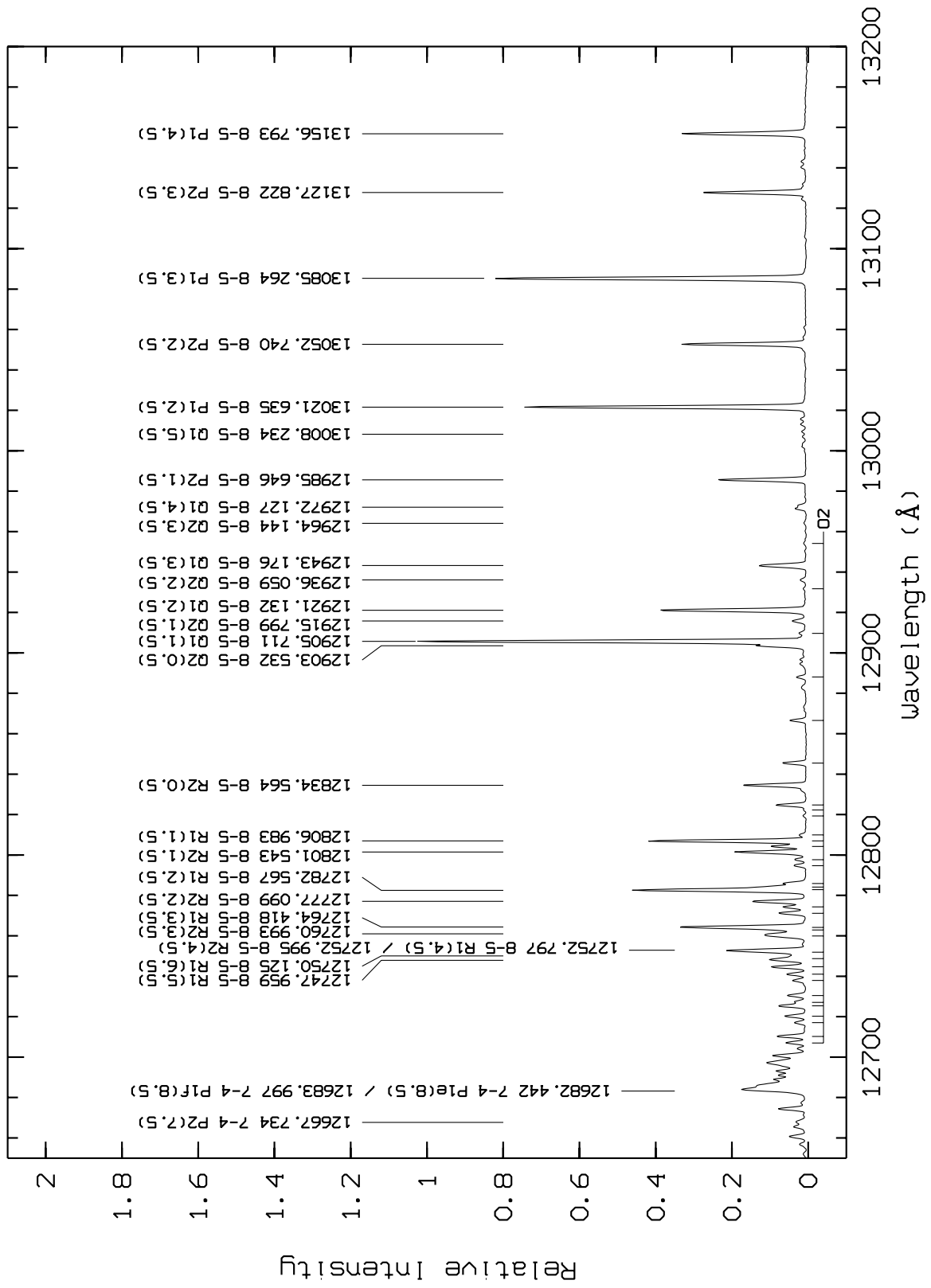


Figure 7: MR spectrum, [1.265–1.32] μm

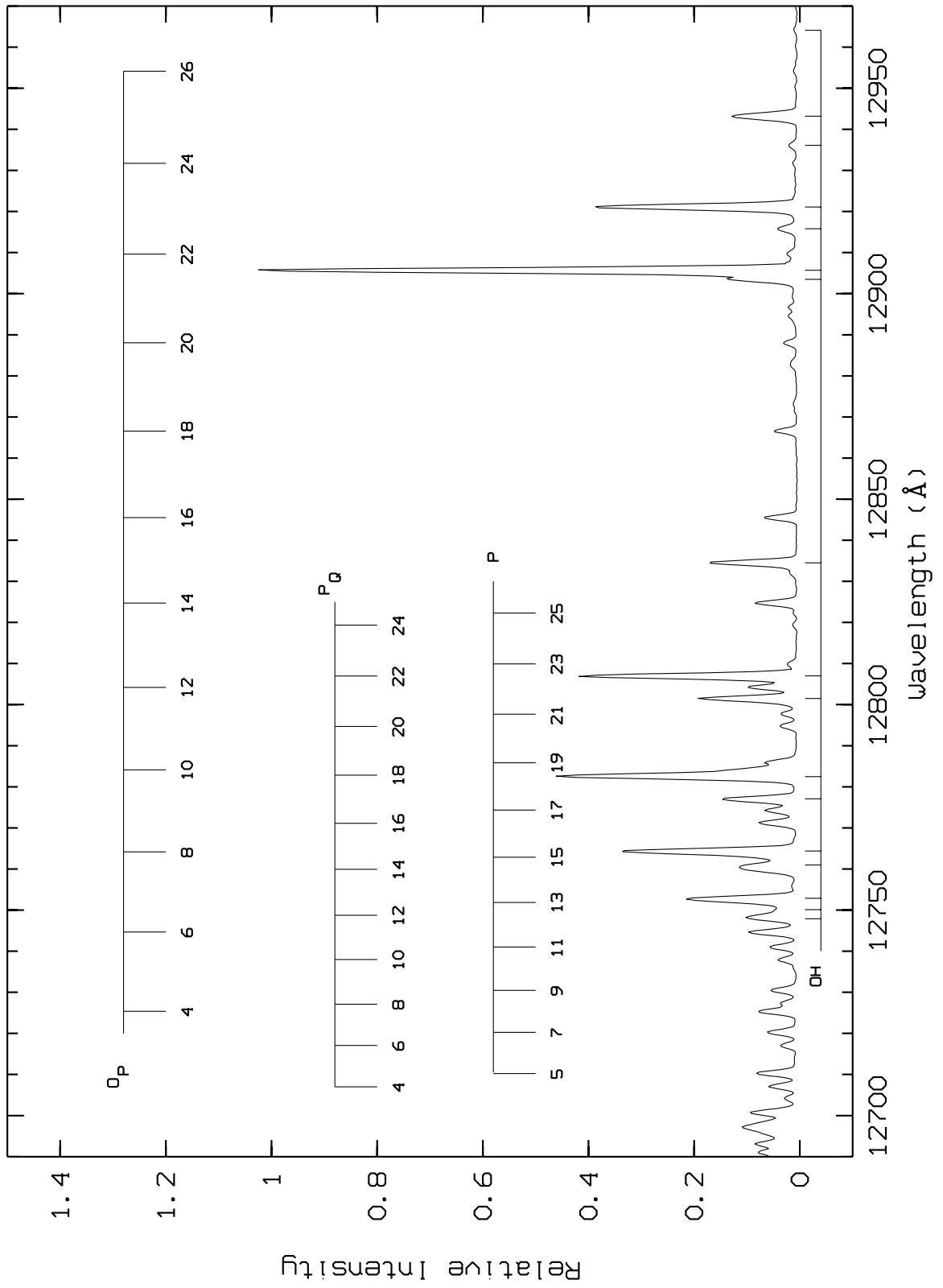


Figure 8: MR spectrum, Detail of the identification of the O₂ lines appearing in the figure 7

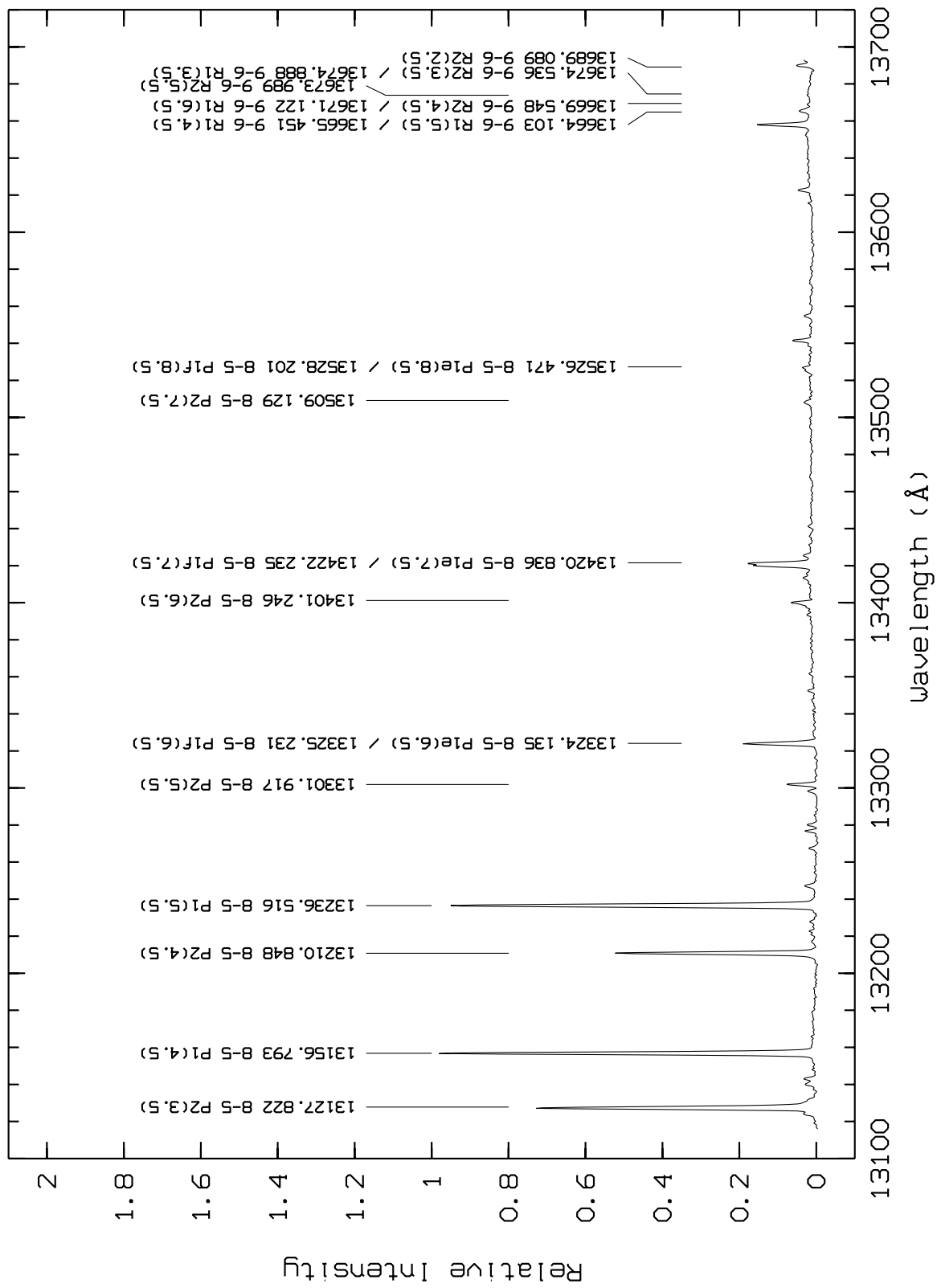


Figure 9: MR spectrum, [1.31–1.37] μm

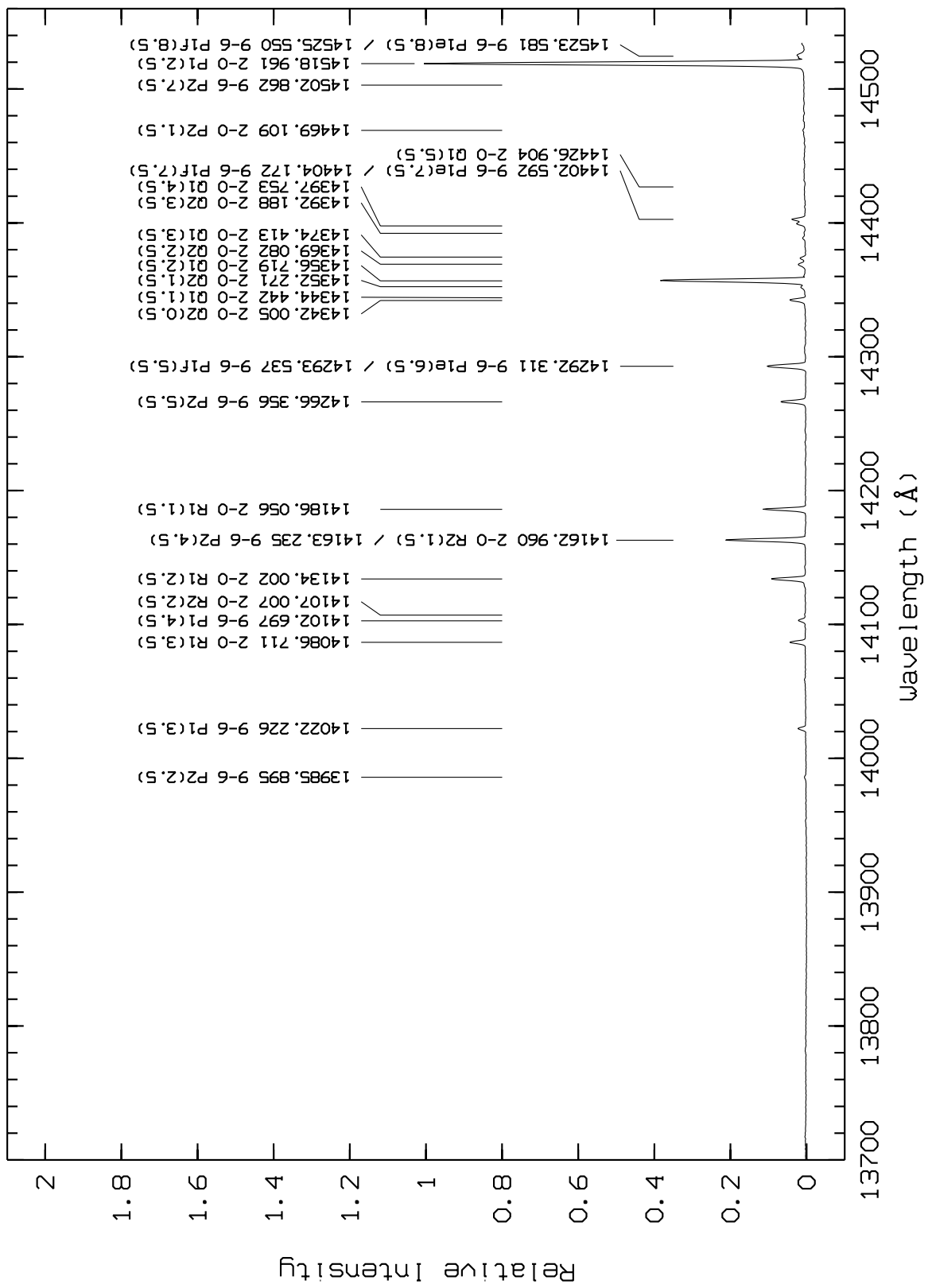


Figure 10: MR spectrum, [1.37–1.455] μm

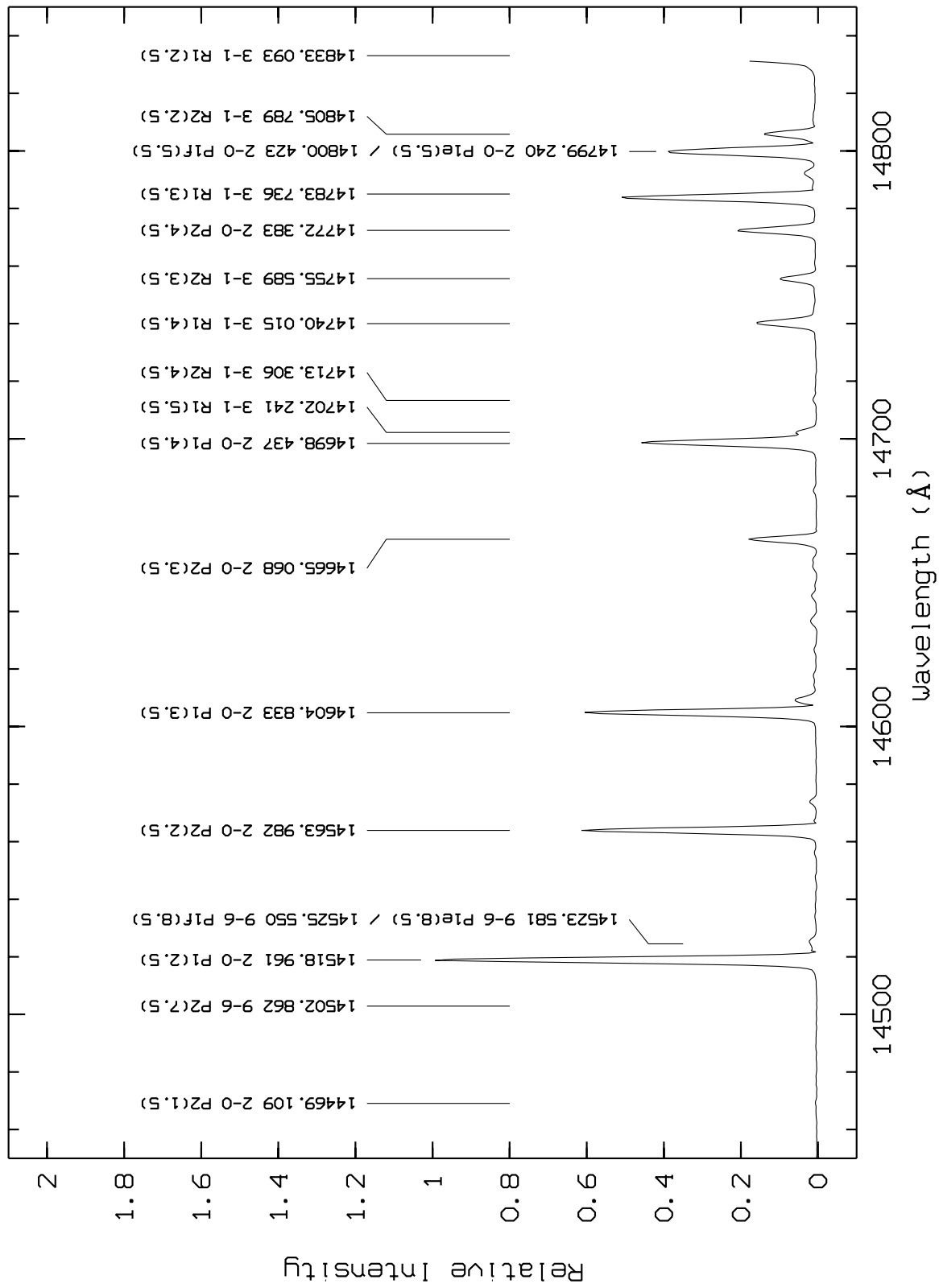


Figure 11: MR spectrum, [1.435–1.483] μm

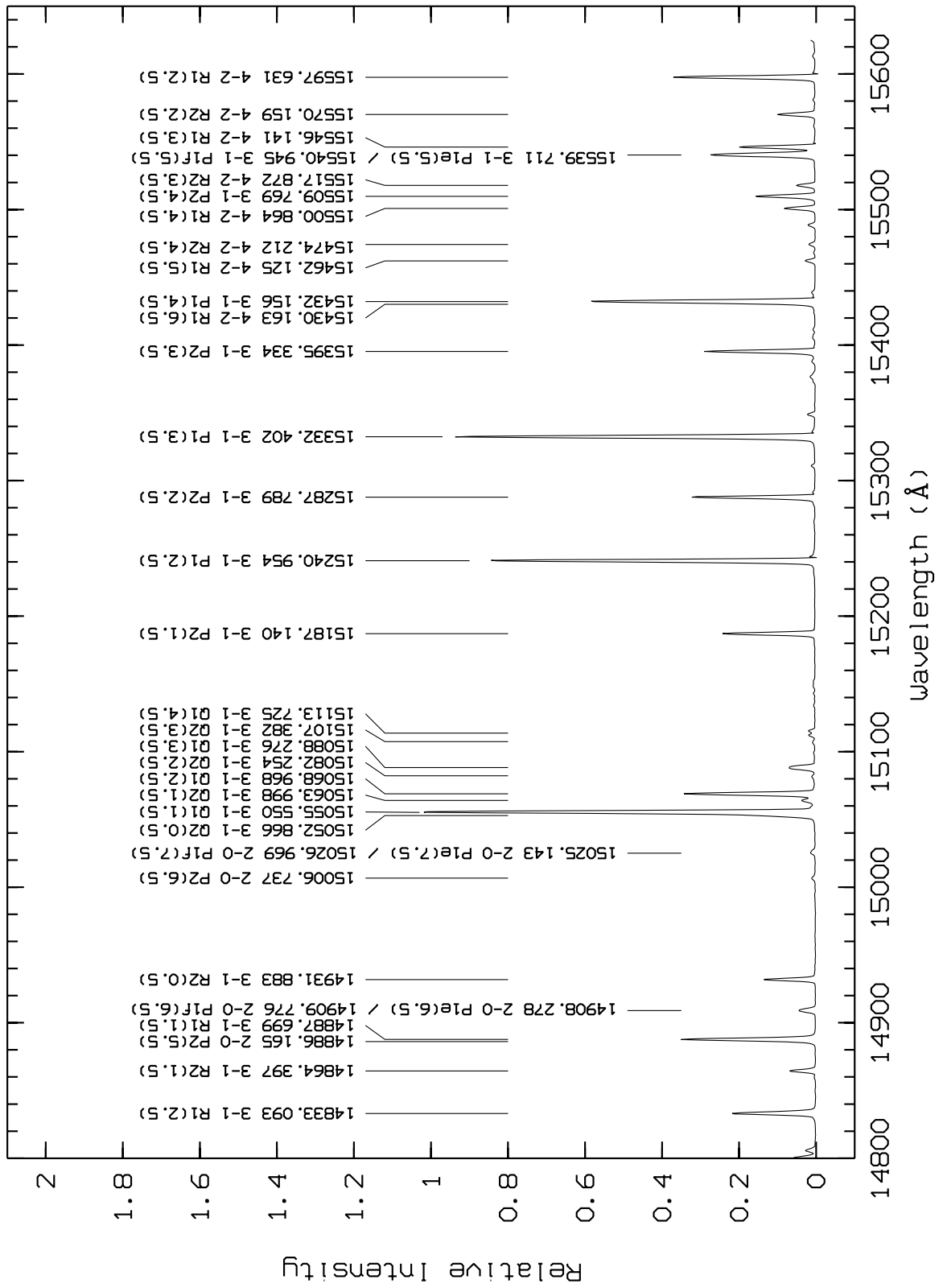


Figure 12: MR spectrum, [1.480–1.562] μm

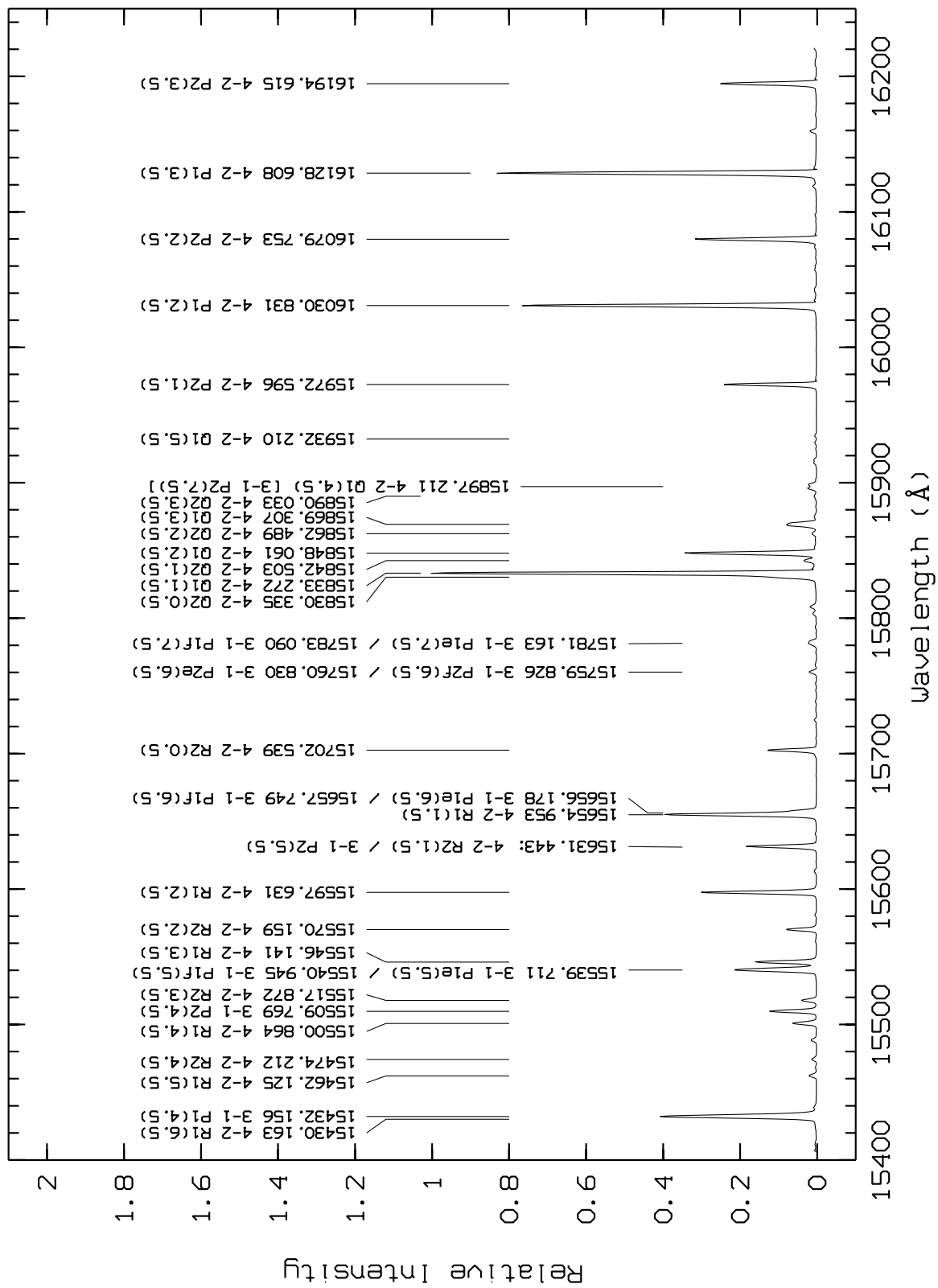


Figure 13: MR spectrum, [1.54–1.622] μm

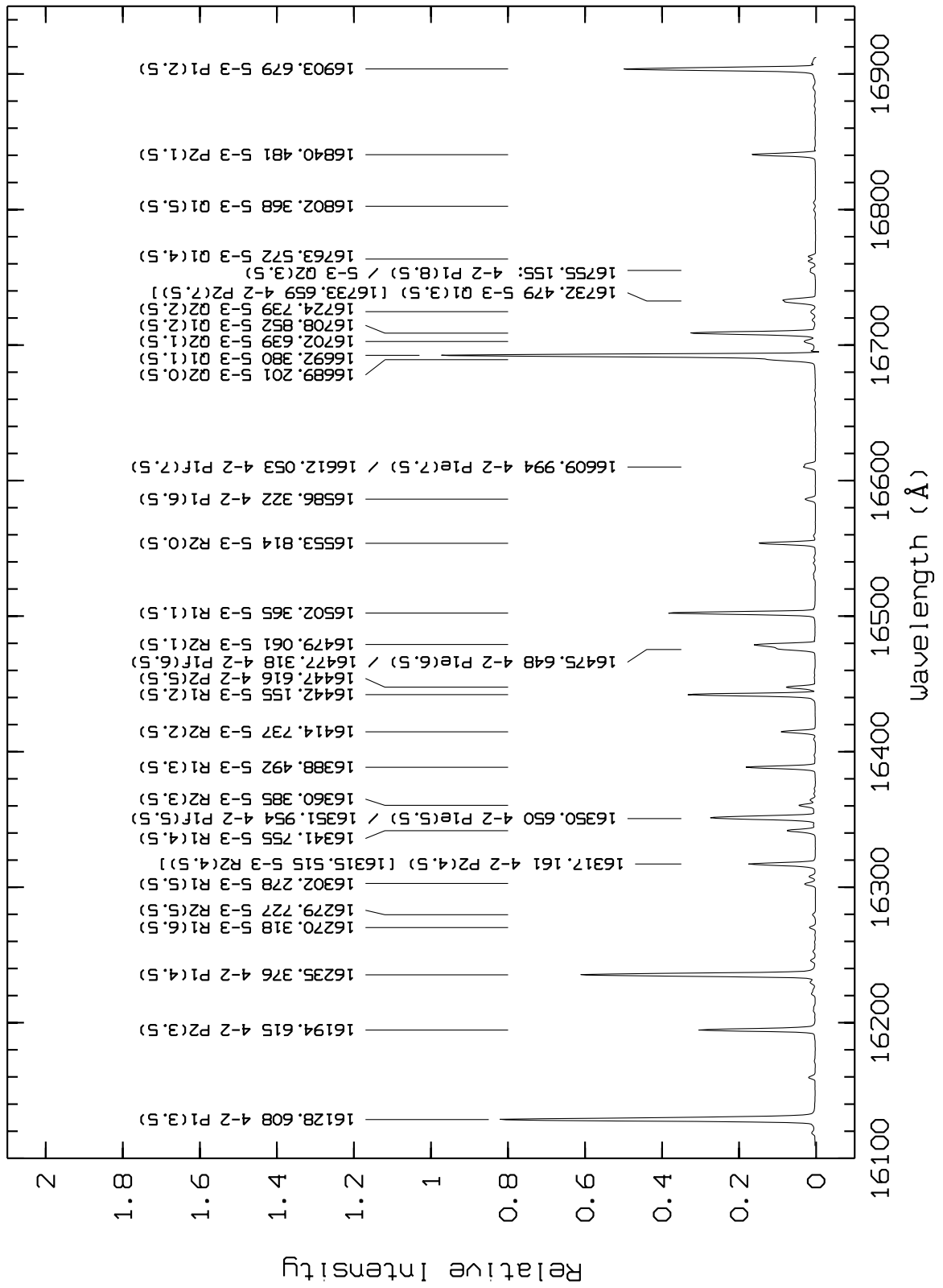


Figure 14: MR spectrum, [1.611–1.691] μm

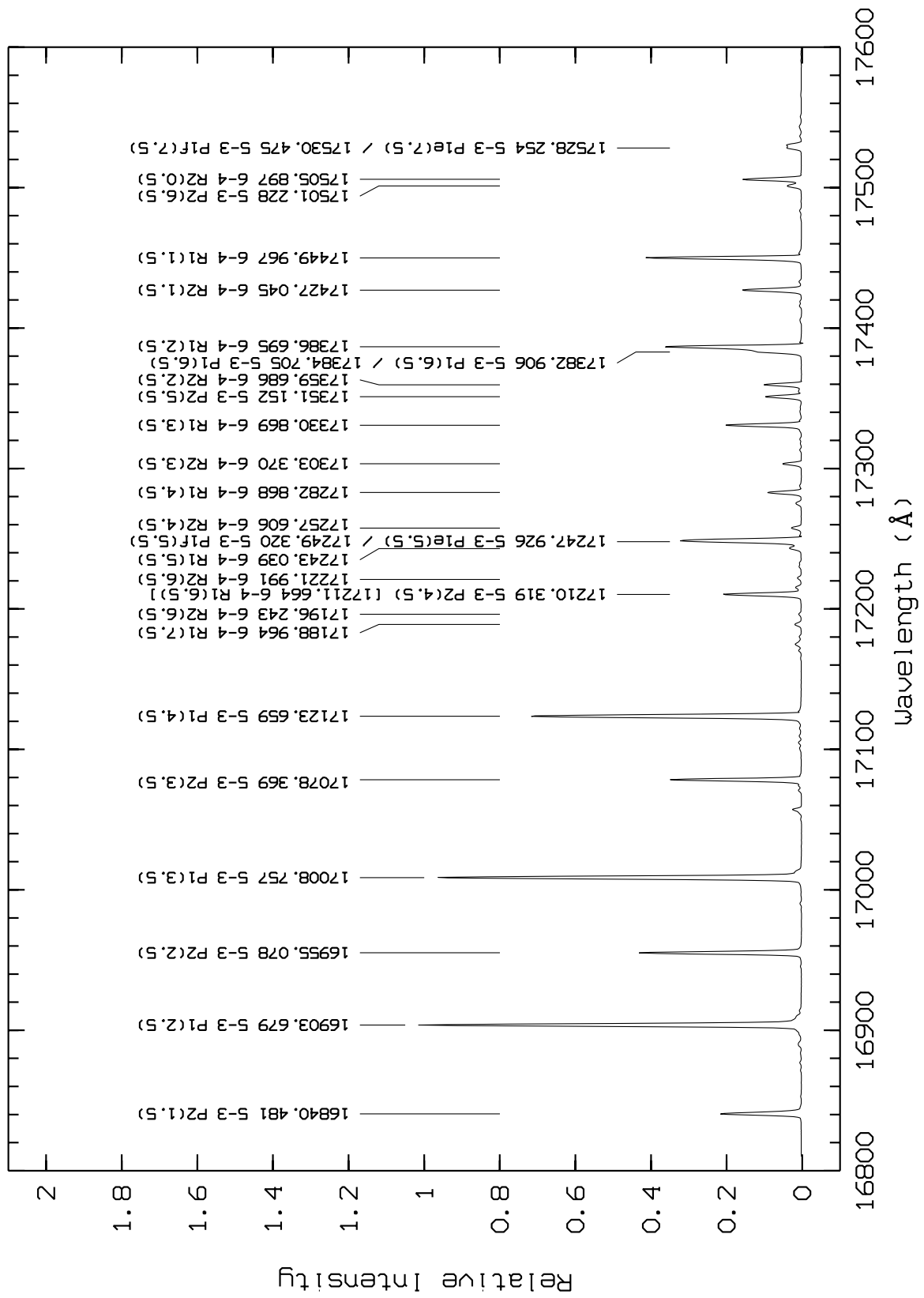


Figure 15: MR spectrum, [1.68–1.76] μm

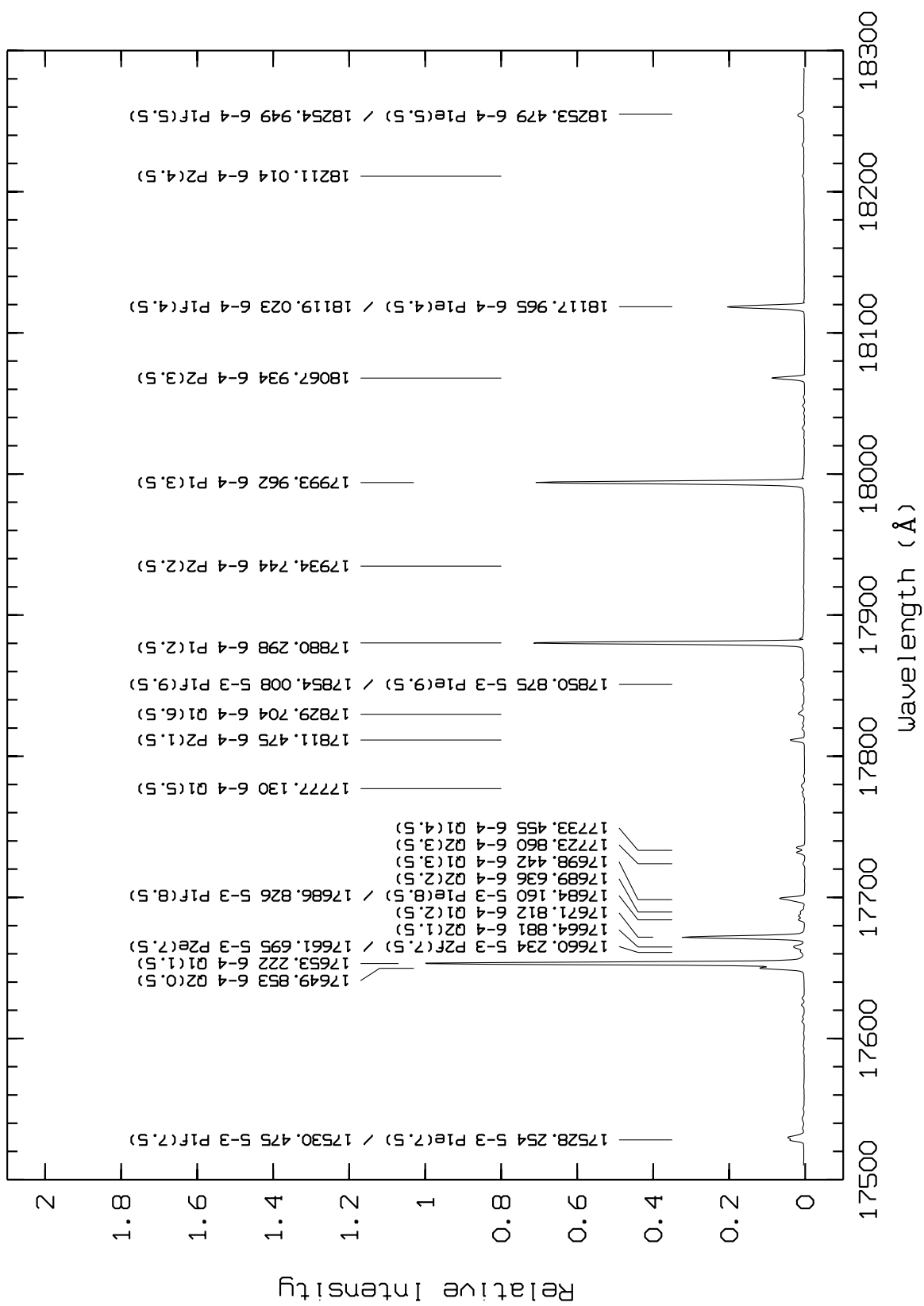


Figure 16: MR spectrum, [1.75–1.83] μm

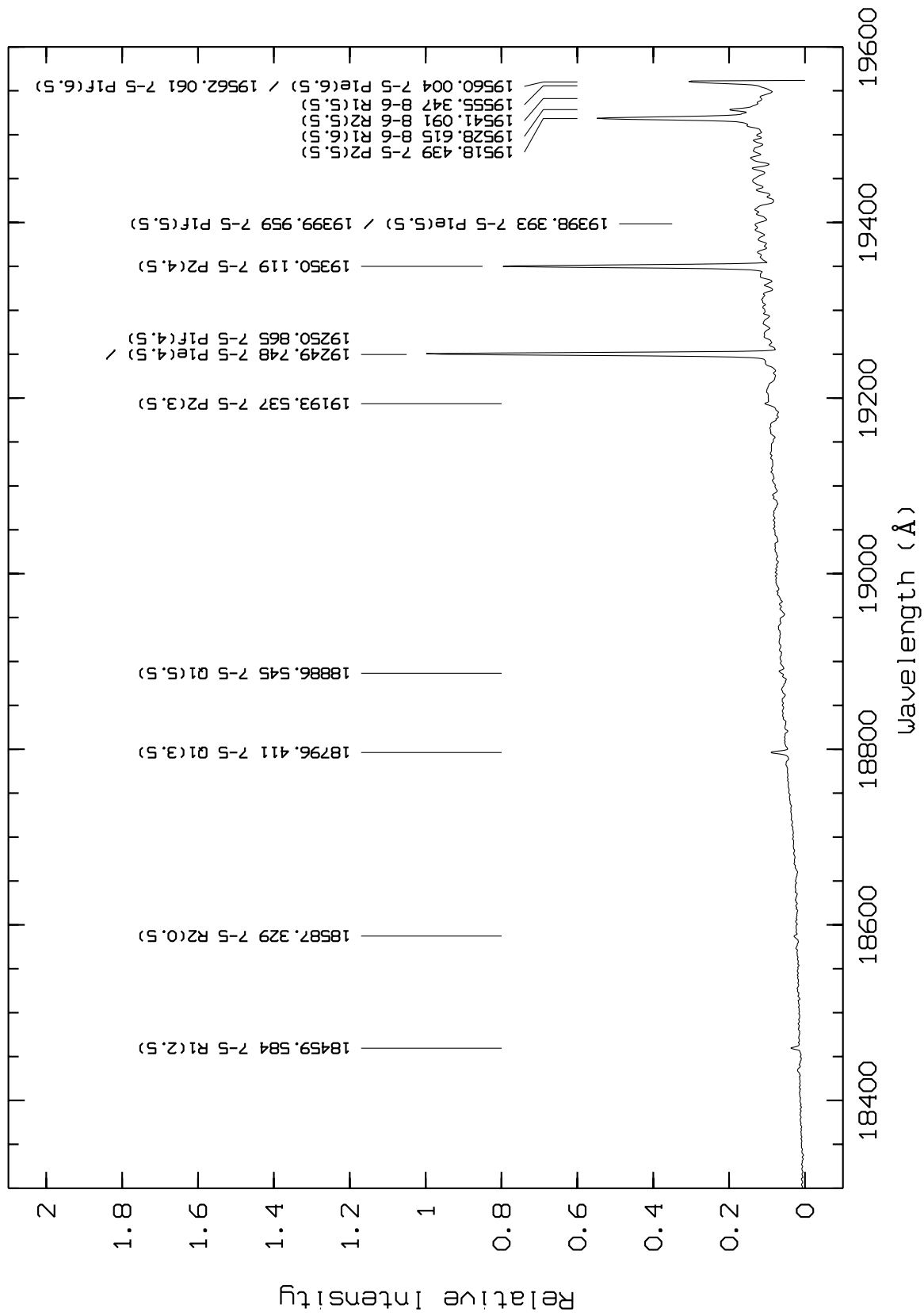


Figure 17: MR spectrum, [1.83–1.956] μm

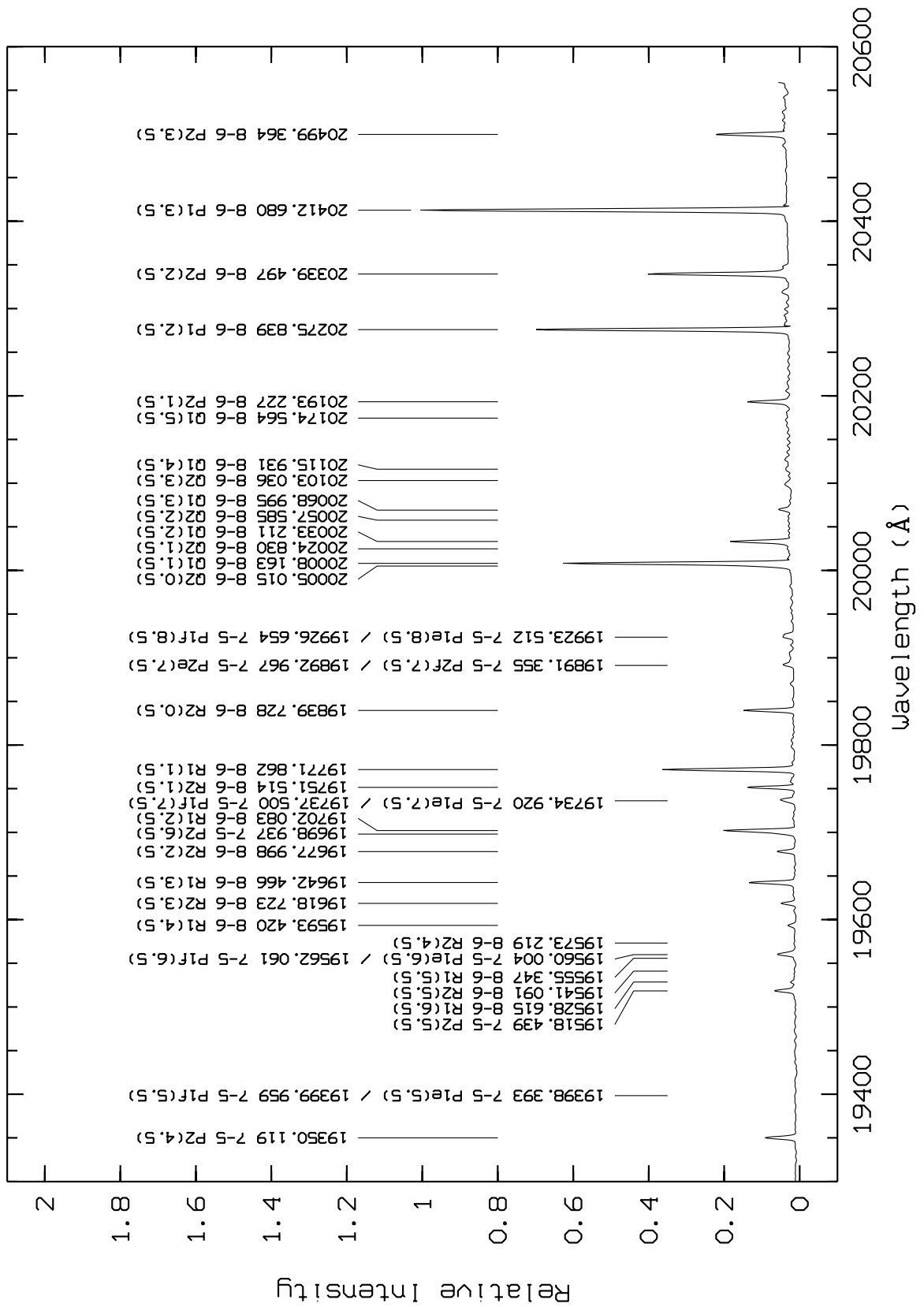


Figure 18: MR spectrum, [1.93–2.056] μm

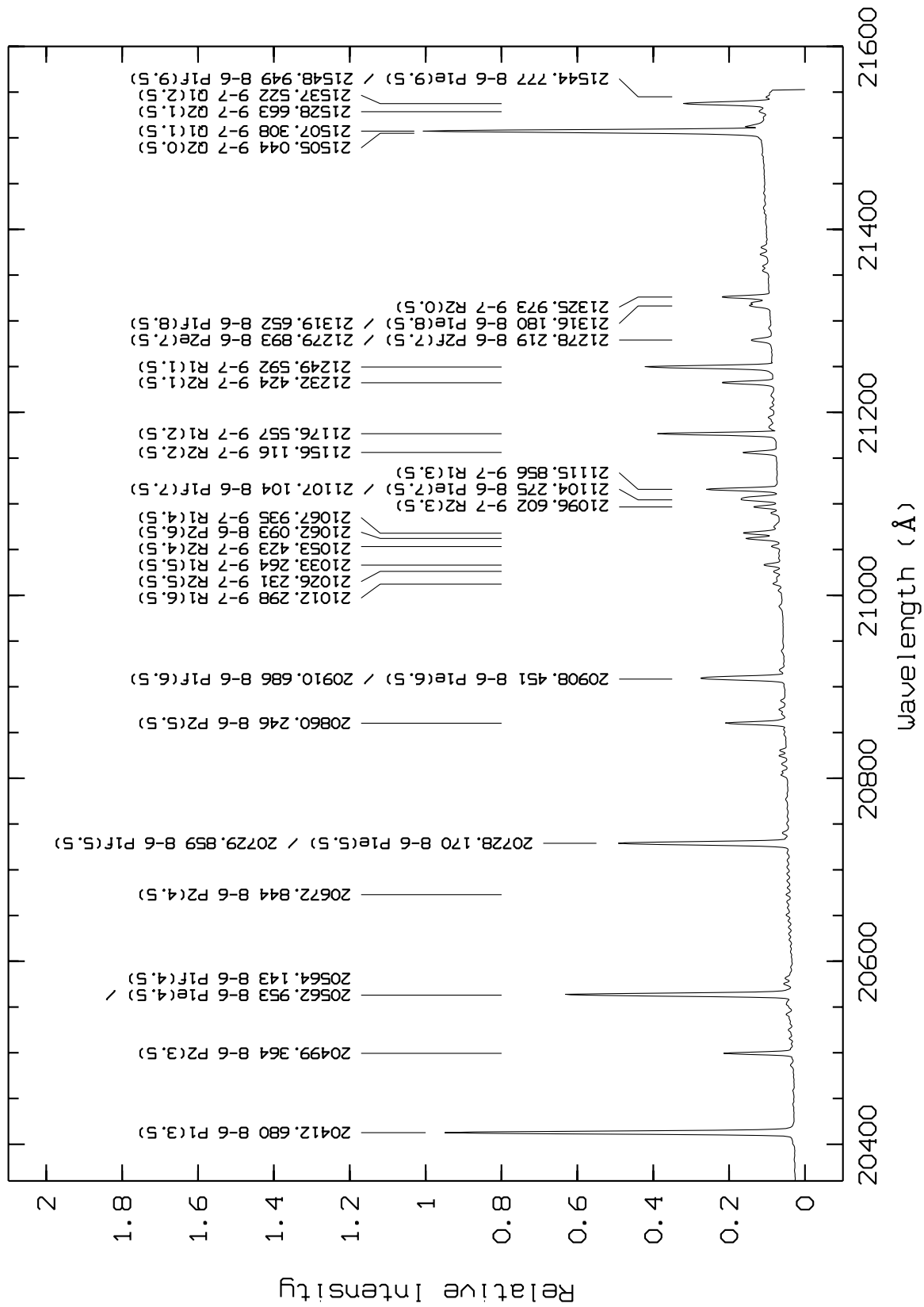


Figure 19: MR spectrum, [2.04–2.155] μm

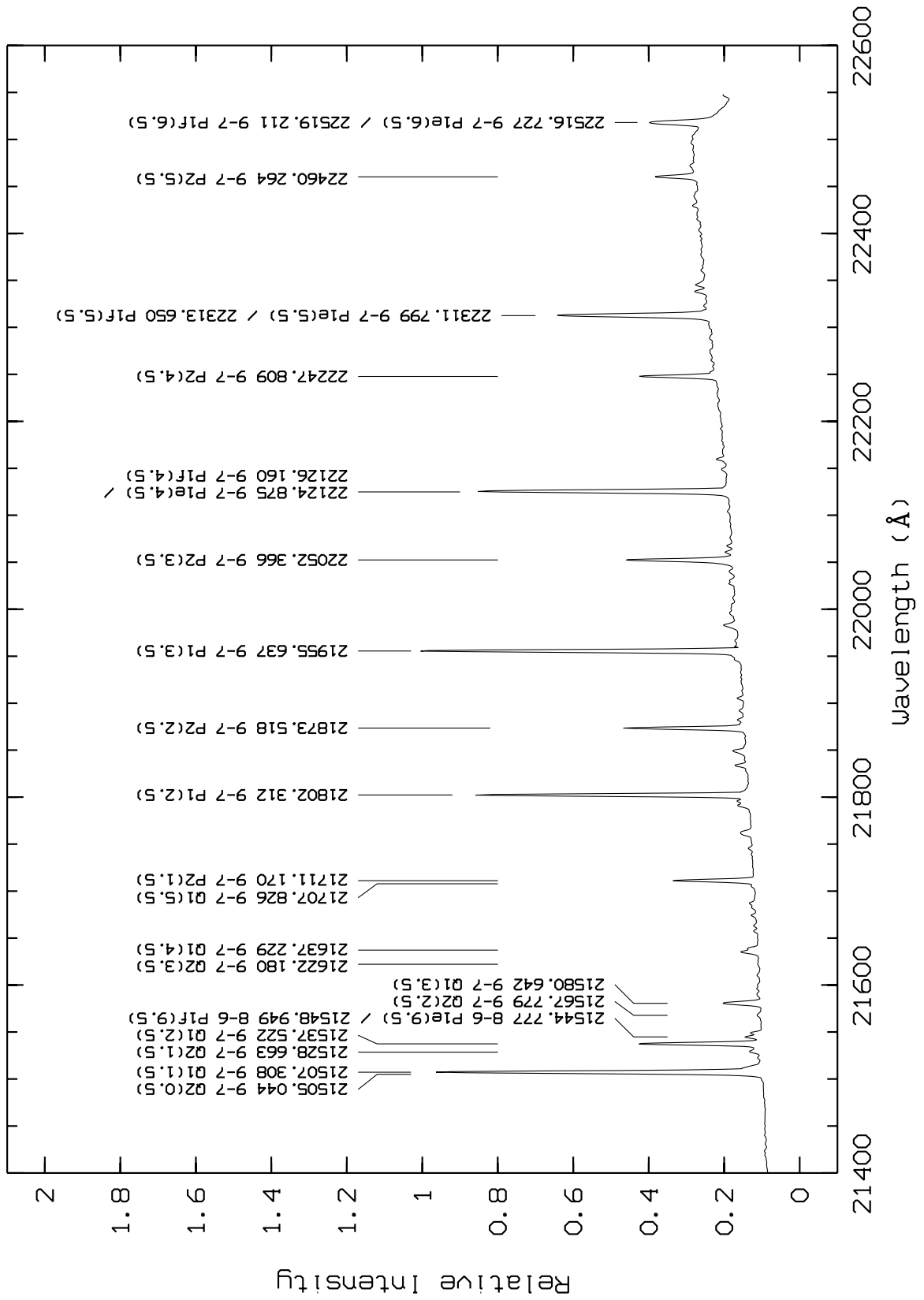


Figure 20: MR spectrum, [2.14-2.255] μm
