1. ESO's Very Large Telescope has captured a stunning image of stars forming in the Large Magellanic Cloud.	
2. The image is of a nebula called N180B, located within the LMC — and is the birthplace of a host of new stars.	
3. N180B's distinctive shape is made up of a <b>collection of giant bubbles</b> .	
4. One of the young stars was <b>spotted emitting a jet</b> .	
5. This is the <b>first time a jet like this has been observed at visible wavelengths</b> outside our galaxy	
6thanks to the <b>relatively low amount of dust in the LMC</b> .	
7. The jet, named Herbig-Haro 1177, is teaching astronomers more about the early lives of stars, both large and small.
